### **Directions to the Hilton from the Charlotte**

From Charlotte take ramp left and follow signs for I-277 North / NC-16 North, at exit 5A, take ramp right for US-21 North / I-77 North toward Statesville, at exit 13A, take ramp right for I-85 North toward Greensboro, at exit 120A, take ramp right for US-29 North / US-70 East / I-85-BR North toward Greensboro. Keep straight onto I-40 North / I-85 East / US-29 East / US-70 North / US-220 North, keep right onto I-40 East / Harriet Morehead Berry Fwy, take Exit #282 (Page Rd.). At bottom of exit, turn right and make an immediate right onto Creekstone Drive (Sleep Inn is at the same turn). Follow the driveway until our entrance.
